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Higher Diploma in Library and Information Management

This programme looks at how information is organised, described, accessed and used with the main purpose of connecting people to the information that they need.

The programme consists of two themes: Library Management and Information Management. The Library Management theme provides a comprehensive training in library management, while the Information Management theme includes some information technology related subjects.

Higher Diploma in Library and Information Management

Diploma in Teacher Librarianship (Primary & Secondary)

This course aims to develop teacher librarians in the skills and knowledge to manage a school library, to build up resources for curriculum development, to assist in teaching and learning and to cultivate in students the attributes of independent inquiry skills. It also develops teacher librarians with personal and professional competencies in resources planning, management and discovery, collaboration among different users, leadership, as well as use of information technology and research methods.

Diploma in Teacher Librarianship (Primary / Secondary)

- The two programmes are commissioned by the Education Bureau
- 2-year part-time programmes
- QF Level 4
- Fee: \$30,000 per installment x 2 installments
- Two streams
 - Primary School Class 11 modules
 - Secondary School Class 12 modules
- Target Students:
 - Holder of a teacher's certificate or equivalent, with a minimum of two-year teaching experience
- Lessons are normally held in weekday evenings, and some on Tuesday and Saturday daytime
- Commencement date: October 2022

Certificate for Library Assistants (Chinese / English classes)

Jointly with HKLA since 1964

The programme develops skills and techniques required by library assistants in identification, acquisition, storage, organization, use and circulation of information.

- Fee: \$12,000
- Two streams
 - Chinese class lectures in Thursday evenings and Saturday daytime
 - English class lectures in Tuesday evenings and Saturday daytime

Certificate in Conservation and Preservation of Books and Documents 書籍維護與修復證書





Master of Information Studies & Graduate Diploma of Information Studies


At your own study pace!

- There are three Sessions (terms) per year
- Graduate Diploma students should take SEVEN 8-credit-point modules, ONE 4-credit-point module, and TWO 2-credit-point modules; those modules are compulsory, then
- Students can choose to exit to get a Graduate Diploma award; or
- Students can continue to take FOUR 8-credit-point elective modules to complete the Master programme.
- Usually students take ONE module per session, but
- You can still take TWO modules or more per session according to your study pace.
- Commencement date: November 2022


Bachelor of Information Studies

 16 credit-point per Session, but
